



Ksi Lisims LNG Receives Nation-Building Project Status

CALGARY, AB — Today the Government of Canada announced that the Ksi Lisims LNG project has been deemed to be of national importance and significance and has been referred to the Major Projects Office. This recognition from the Government of Canada signals that the Ksi Lisims LNG project can strengthen Canada's economy, advance economic reconciliation with Indigenous Nations, and diversify markets for Canada's energy resources.

Ksi Lisims LNG is a proposed net-zero LNG export facility on Canada's northwest coast, being co-developed by the Nisga'a Nation, Western LNG and Rockies LNG. The project is designed to be one of the lowest-emission LNG facilities globally, powered by renewable hydroelectricity and built on floating platforms in a remote location to minimize land and community impacts. Major project status will support the Ksi Lisims LNG project as it moves towards a final investment decision.

"This project will significantly expand global market access for Canadian natural gas producers" said Brendan McCracken, CEO and President of Ovintiv, one of the partners in Rockies LNG. "We are encouraged to see the Government of Canada recognize the important role of our natural gas sector in growing our economy and opening new markets."

"These nation-building projects create significant economic benefits for Canadians. The upstream natural gas production associated with the Ksi Lisims project is expected to create an estimated 12,000 jobs and increase GDP by \$3.5 billion per year once operational" said Charlotte Raggett, President & CEO of Rockies LNG. "We anticipate that the growth in production of natural gas to supply the Ksi Lisims LNG project will result in over \$45 billion in private sector investment over the life of the project."

Rockies LNG is a partnership of Western Canadian natural gas producers working together to develop LNG export opportunities for Canadian natural gas. The partners in Rockies LNG collectively produce more than half of Canada's natural gas and are committed to responsible development of Canadian natural gas resources.

Ksi Lisims LNG is a proposed floating natural gas liquefaction and export facility located on the north coast of British Columbia, within the modern treaty territory of the Nisga'a Nation. The project is a partnership between the Nisga'a Nation, Western LNG, and Rockies LNG. Designed to be one of the world's lowest-emission LNG facilities, Ksi Lisims LNG aims to foster sustainable economic development and lasting prosperity in Canada's northwest.

About the Nisga'a Nation and Western LNG

The Nisga'a Nation is a self-governing, modern treaty Nation with defined control and rights over their lands. Ksi Lisims LNG will be sited on land owned by the Nisga'a Nation at the northeastern tip of Pearse Island in British Columbia. Rockies LNG Partners is a limited partnership comprised of Canadian natural gas producers formed to advance LNG market access opportunities on the west coast of British Columbia.
